



Mask Policy

The doctors at our practice want to keep the health and safety of EVERY patient, parent, caregiver, employee and each of their extended family members as our priority. Since business owners are able to determine their own policy regarding wearing a mask within their establishment, we have decided to strictly adhere to current mask recommendations.

Masks are recommended or required by the Centers of Disease Control, the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry, the American Dental Association, the American Orthodontic Association, the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners, the Texas Dental Association and the Greater Houston Dental Society, OSHA, and every other healthcare related governing body that our doctors are members of and governed by.

We are requiring that everyone over the age of 10 years old wear a mask while inside our office. Our office also highly recommends masks for children over the age of 2 if they are able.
